You are cordially invited to the 4th Batsford Weekend; this is a two day event which will include:

- Field shoot on Saturday 24th May
- Flight shoot and a Fun shoot including archery darts and shoot an apple of the head on Saturday
- Roving Mark on Sunday 25th May

Registration will begin at 9.00am Saturday

Captain of the Marks will be Mr John Holder Esq.

Archers from various European countries have been invited to shoot in their traditional style using traditional equipment.

There will be no bow classes, just Gender/Age classes and all traditional bows will shoot against each other.

Camping is available on the site as last year, Camping Costs will be incorporated into the overall weekend fee, This covers the Land owners fee and the Toilet/Marquee hire.

Cost for the Weekend is £20.00 / €30.00 and should be paid with your entry form in advance.

We will have a good sized marquee on site, but it must be our turn for some decent weather!

You will need some blunts for the fun shoot. Please bring blunts or wine bottle corks to put on your arrows.

There will be a Social gathering and film show on the campsite on Friday night

There will be another Social Gathering with a live band on the campsite on Saturday night

Please get your entries in early as this shoot is: limited to 100 archers, last year we had to turn people away due to them getting their entries in at the last minute.
